Further to our recent conversation, please find enclosed my additional costs claim for July. As you will see it is substantial. This is because I am in the process of moving. I have sold my flat at [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Future claims will relate to this. The purchase took place in November 2003, but I was obliged to rent out the property until I had sold the flat at [REDACTED]. I took possession of the new property from July 1.

The new property has been purchased on a two-year interest only mortgage with the Co-op Bank. The amount of the mortgage is £179,000 and the current monthly interest repayments are £720.30 per month. The terms of the mortgage mean that it will have to be renegotiated at the end of the year. I will inform you of this in due course.

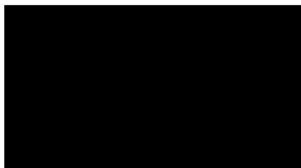
I am in the process of redecorating [REDACTED] inside and out and making some minor alterations, such as installing bookshelves. I have obtained two quotations and accepted the lower of the two. As you suggested, I have asked the contractor to divide these into two and the first half is charged to this month. I am also charging for some furnishings such as lampshades and a desk, although most of the furniture will come from my previous property.

Finally, I have charged removal costs and the cost of storing the furniture for the three months interval between leaving [REDACTED] and regaining possession of [REDACTED]. Receipts are enclosed.
