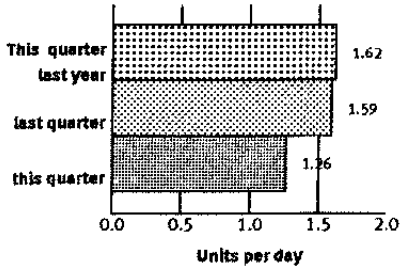

Additional Costs Allowance (ACA) 2009/2010

Thank you for your ACA (now PAAE) claim dated 17 May 2009, a copy of which is enclosed for ease of reference.

With reference to your claim of £800.00 for food, for April and May; as from 1 April the food allowance was replaced by a subsistence allowance. The subsistence allowance allows members to claim £25 for each night spent at their second home.

Please note that Members should claim for the actual number of overnight stays rather than forecast how many nights they intend to stay for the period of their claim.

You may either resubmit the claim for subsistence immediately, entering the actual number of overnight stays as at the relevant date; or wait until the end of the month before submitting a claim for the full period.

The balance of your claim, totalling £4,023.90, has been processed and the funds should reach your account within the next few days.
